The portal already has the background information about the property – such as the year of construction, the area or the type of heat generation – as it receives the relevant data from different public sources. You can include recent renovations in the assessment. Once the property valuation and objectives definition have been completed, you receive an individual package of measures for the sustainable modernisation of your property.

Cantonal promotion measures

Some cantons promote energy-related renovations through financial support or tax benefits. The federal and cantonal building programme is intended to reduce energy consumption and CO₂ emissions in Switzerland. If you decide to carry out such a renovation, you can check in advance how much support you will receive from the canton. The cantonal websites provide a detailed description of the submission process, so that you can apply for the necessary documents on time and ensure that funding is disbursed.
