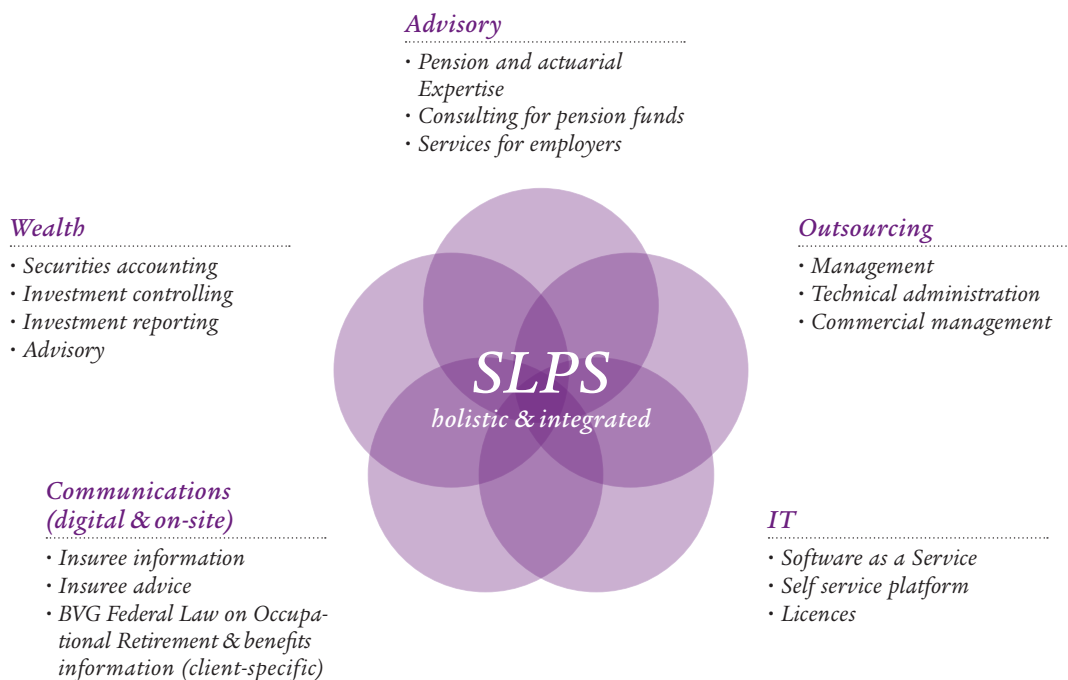
Swiss Life Pension Services – Our new partner

The following diagram depicts the integrated services by SLPS:



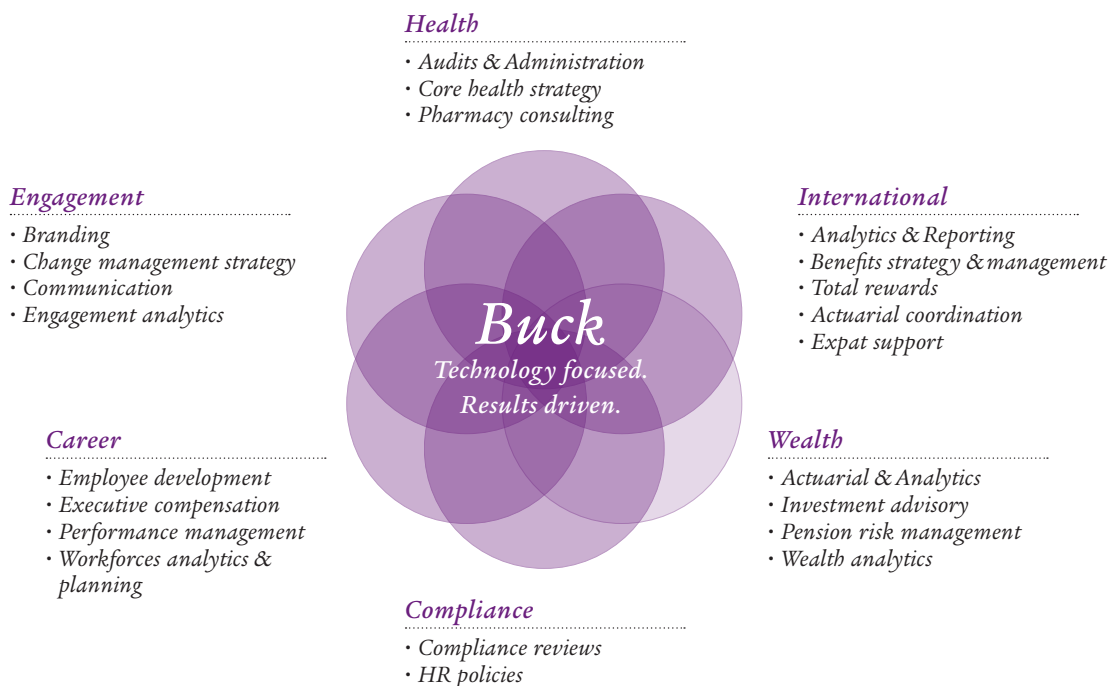
Our new partner: Buck
